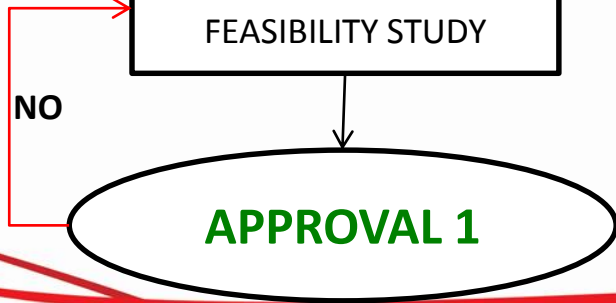

- Appoint a Transaction Advisor

Project Inception & Registration

“As soon as an MDA or MMDA (Contracting Authority) identifies a project that may be concluded as a PPP, the institution must in writing accompanied by a Project Brief/Concept Note –


- Register the project with MOF-PID;
- Inform MOF-PID of the expertise within that institution to proceed with the project;
- Appoint a Project Officer from within or outside the institution; and
- Appoint a Transaction Advisor if MOF-PID so requests.”

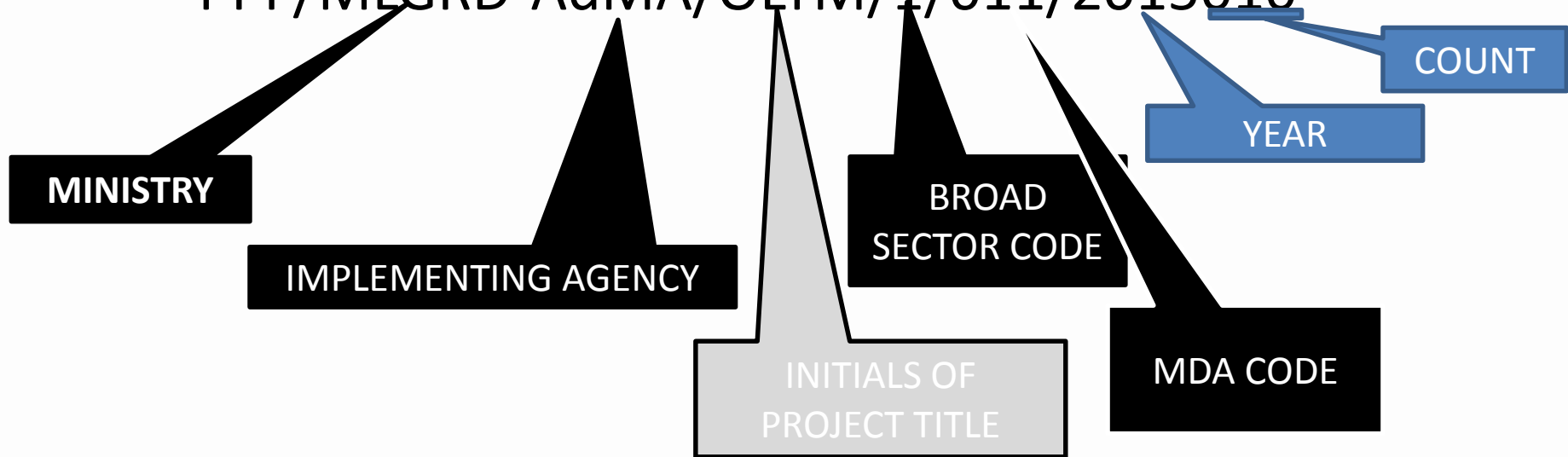
